### **Notice of Public Availability of Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Fair Oaks Overhead Bridge Rehabilitation Project**

**WHAT'S BEING PLANNED:**

The City of Sunnyvale (City) proposes to rehabilitate the Fair Oaks Overhead Bridge (bridge). The bridge is located on Fair Oaks Avenue between Kifer Road and Evelyn Avenue. The bridge crosses over Hedy Avenue, the railroad tracks owned by the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board (Caltrain), and through an apartment community. The Fair Oaks Avenue Overhead Bridge Rehabilitation Project (project) would rehabilitate the bridge to address several identified structural deficiencies while at the same time expanding bicycle and pedestrian amenities. The rehabilitated bridge would maintain its current automobile capacity – two travel lanes in each direction.

**WHY THIS NOTICE:**

A draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has been prepared for the project. This notice is to inform you of the availability of the Draft EIR for public review. In compliance with CEQA Guidelines, the City has filed a separate Notice of Completion form with the California State Clearinghouse to inform state agencies of the availability of the Draft EIR.
